1. Welcome Gary Beck Dallaghan

3. NBME UPDATE Gary Beck Dallaghan

Gary informed everyone about the continued work with the NBME. He has had a couple of phone calls with Brownie Anderson and Jonathan Rubright about the results of the work undertaken during their session at the July meeting. Jonathan noted that the topics of interest and excitement for SDRME members aligned well with topics of conversation occurring within NBME. These included:

 - Assessment for vs of learning
 - Formative, lower-stakes assessment
 - Educational links to patient care/outcomes

- Systems of assessments, including longitudinal information

- “Tension” with psychometrics: investigating the topics above outside of high-stakes

For next steps, Jonathan is investigating funding for literature reviews on specific topics of interest, including those above. The rationale for this is that he said they come up with ideas for assessments at the NBME but often times do not have the bandwidth to undertake a rigorous review of the literature to determine what works best. He is currently working on this and will be reaching out in the coming months.

He also let everyone know that we would be taking a hit for canceling the in-person meeting, but some of those funds will be applied to the 2023 final bill.
