Proposals should include the following:

- Title
- Speaker(s)
- Why is the topic important and its relevance to medical education scholarship?
- Objectives:
  - What will the participants learn or be able to do as a result of this session?
- Methods and Session Format:
  - Indicate the amount of time to be allocated to each speaker or element of the program.
  - Describe the format of the session and the methods that will be used to engage the participants.
- Proposal Format:
  - Length should be no more than one page, single spaced with 1-inch margins, using 12-point font size.
